<p>Show and Tell- Mark Hottowe</p>	<p>Mark spoke to the group about the future direction of the Ocean Beach School District in the curriculum and in facility needs. Mark said he has two goals as the Super Intendant:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student learning and to develop higher achieving students through collaborations of teaching staff and the community. 2. To make sure that students and instructors have the necessary facilities to develop higher achieving students. <p>Mark announced that in a joint effort OBSD and Willapa Behavioral Health have made it possible for counselors to be available in all schools in the district on both a set and rotating schedule.</p> <p>Mark spoke about the possibility of OBSD converting to the Common Core teaching method that is currently practiced in several states in the nation. It keeps the current educational basic concepts and standards, but is structured differently in how information is relayed to students. OBSD is waiting to hear whether they are awarded the Healthy Kids/Safe Schools grant that will bring millions of dollars into the district. OBSD was one of three districts in the state of Washington who were eligible to apply.</p>	

<p>Business Asset Builder Award- Ocean Park Retreat Center</p>	<p>Willis Williams accepted the award on behalf of the Ocean Beach Retreat Center. The Ocean Park Retreat Center has collaborated extensively with WellSpring and the schools to provide Adventure Day to all 6th graders and has opened up use of the ropes course to other nonprofit groups.. Willis has worked at the center for nearly a decade as director and will be retiring in October.</p>
