Rosanne spoke about the Town Hall meeting and that 78 people attended. Discussion went to the importance of branding. The question was how do we "own it"?

The "Take a Second. Make a Difference" was discussed and it was agreed by most members that it would be a positive campaign to introduce to the Peninsula and help further promote the 40 Developmental Assets. Tara Finch moved that we adopt "Take a Second - Make a Difference" as our new campaign and Jean Fischer seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Brooke Larson and Monica Younger gave a demonstration about what they learned at the CADCA National Academy about Logic Model & Planning. We then did a demonstration on how the **Seven Strategies to Affect Community Change** can be applied to our different teams.

The Chair then discussed the need to focus on one substance in order to bring about greater community change. Alcohol was the chosen substance for the Coalition to concentrate on, Barbara Bates made the motion & Shelly Carter seconded it. Motion passed.

Katie Lindstrom talked about the cuts made to the Grant for Community Mobilization. Tara Finch made the motion to accept the lower amount and Geri Marcus seconded it. It was approved.

Brooke made the announcement that all were invited to Vision & Mission on June 15<sup>th</sup> from 1:00-3:00. Also, following next month's Coalition Meeting on July 13<sup>th</sup> there will be a Town Hall Follow-up at the Peninsula Senior Center from 5:30-7:30PM.
